International Student Ambassador Service Award (ISASA) 2025 Call for Nominations

The International Advisory Council and Office of Global Engagement (OGE) are pleased to call for nominations for the International Student Ambassador Service Award (ISASA) which recognizes the service of international students, particularly those who contribute to UIC's international cross-cultural or intercultural understanding.

The ISASA honors international students who are currently attending UIC on an international student visa and have made outstanding contributions to the University through campus and/or community service, particularly by contributing to greater knowledge and understanding across our diverse national cultures. Student nominees must have contributed a significant amount of time and effort to projects, activities or causes that advance intercultural and international understanding on the UIC campus and/or amongst the local community.

International students engaged in intercultural activities are strongly encouraged to apply. In addition, OGE encourages faculty, staff and students to consider nominating an international student. UIC international students at every level on all UIC campuses are eligible.

STUDENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- 1. Full time degree-seeking UIC students in any discipline who are international (those on an international student visa) at the undergraduate, graduate, or professional level.
- 2. Overall minimum GPA of 2.5 (on a 4-point scale).

Up to (2) students will receive a \$500 monetary award and will be recognized at the Office of Global Engagement International Student Awards Ceremony Wednesday, April 16, 2025. The application deadline is **5 p.m. on 28 February 2025.** Results will be announced via email, within four weeks after the deadline.

Only complete applications will be considered. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that all parts of the application are submitted together as one document in the specified order below except for the Academic Reference Form which must be submitted by the faculty or staff member from their university email address. All application materials should be submitted via email to $\underline{oge(a)uic.edu.}$

APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

- 1. Personal Information Form (see below): Must be completed and signed by applicant.
- 2. Cover letter outlining the most significant contributions by the student to increasing intercultural knowledge and understanding at UIC or in the community. Please ensure the cover letter references the service activities in the resume or CV and includes organization name, position, dates, and responsibilities.
- 3. Resume or CV including academic awards or honors, clubs, activities, internships, volunteer work, and employment.
- 4. Academic Reference Form(s): The form must be completed by a UIC faculty or staff member and submitted separately by the referee via their UIC e-mail to <u>oge@uic.edu</u>. The maximum number of references is two (2).
